About FEAT

FEAT is a Townsville based community organisation that provides housing and support services to families who are either homeless or experiencing a housing crisis.

FEAT was established in 1978 and is well known and respected for its work in the local community.

In 2018 FEAT celebrated its 40th year and as part of looking to the future the 'FEAT Community Fund' was established.

What is the FEAT Community Fund?

In 2018 to celebrate 40 years of service and our broader commitment to improving the lives of the people we work with the FEAT Community Fund was established.

The Fund aims to assist people aged between 16-40, who have experienced homelessness or a housing crisis, to improve their future employment and cultural opportunities. This initiative has been funded using a variety of donations including Commonwealth Bank, Willows Presbyterian Church as well as funds from FFAT.

The fund is intended to be ongoing with FEAT adding to the fund annually.



Eligibility to Apply

- People aged between 16-40 years,
- Applicants must live in Townsville.
- Applicants must be on a low income,
- Applications are to be based upon increasing employment or cultural opportunities.



Grant Size

Up to \$1,500 per application.

However FEAT may approve applications over this amount - in full, or in part (to provide some assistance towards your goals). Please still apply.



What can I apply for?

Individuals are encouraged to seek funding from FEAT Community Fund for:



Text books



Laptop for study



Course fees



Training events



Uniforms/equipment used for training



This list provides examples of the grants that could be applied for. The FEAT Community Fund will consider other requests.

What should I NOT apply for?

Grant applications are for one off cost rather than ongoing costs. FEAT will not accept applications for the following type of requests:

- Mobile phones
- Household items
- Daily living expenses
- Food or rental costs
- Payment of school fees



Grant Application Rounds

There will be a number of rounds each year. The opening and closing application times for the Funding Rounds can be found on FEAT's website, www.feat.org.au.

Applications received outside funding round timeframes may be considered at the discretion of the decision-making group. Multiple rounds of funding will be available during the year.
